

Romans 6:23 (NIV):

“For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.”

This verse shows us a clear truth: God offers a gift—grace and eternal life—but sin comes with a price. Every sin has its wages, and those wages must eventually be paid.
